



How to Do a Questions & Answer Study / WORKSHEET

A Question and Answer Study (Q&A) is simply put a topical study that begins at a different starting point and ending point. Instead of beginning with a topic, you start with a question, usually about a topic or that leads to a topic. Instead of ending with a summary about the topic, it ends with an answer to the question. You will see easily see the similarities between a topical study and a Q&A study.

This is the last type of study to complete. Here are the simple steps. Have fun!

1. Write out your question.
2. List key words related to your question.
3. List verses based on key words using a concordance or online Bible tool (www.blueletterbible.com)
4. Read through verses and select key verses
5. Complete a verse analysis on key verses using what you learned in the Verse Analysis Study lesson.
6. Summarize the findings of your verse studies.
7. How do your findings relate to answering your question?
8. List other questions and problems that have come up as a result of your study.
9. Complete a summary paper including the answer to your question and how you would apply what you have learned.
